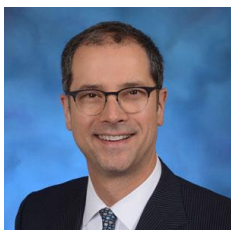


Scott Garberding

Global Chief Manufacturing Officer



Scott R. Garberding was appointed Global Chief Manufacturing Officer in October 2018. He has been a member of the Group Executive Council (GEC) since September 2013. In addition, he holds global responsibility for Comau and Teksid.

Previously, Mr. Garberding was named Head of Quality in May 2016. He has also served as Chief Purchasing Officer. In December 2009, he was named Head of Manufacturing/World Class Manufacturing, FCA US LLC. In this position, he was responsible for all assembly, stamping, and powertrain manufacturing operations worldwide, as well as implementation of the World Class Manufacturing system at all FCA US manufacturing facilities.
